



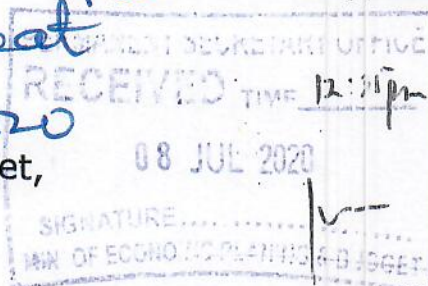




RE: POST COVID ENGAGEMENT WITH THE OBAS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT CHAIRMEN

2.5 Mr. Governor further revealed that Lagos State Government had been working closely with the Federal Government, Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), World Health Organization (WHO) and the Private Sector, to halt the spread of this disease.

2.6 Speaking further, Mr. Governor advised that, there should be no cause for panic among Nigerians over the reported COVID-19 incident because measures have been set in motion by the State and Federal Governments to curtail the spread of the virus across the Country.

2.7 Mr. Governor further revealed that, Lagos State has 2 Bio-Security Facilities that are more than capable to contain the virus. Health workers and emergency officials were on the field to track all persons that had physical contact and interaction with the patient.

2.8 He advised people of 50yrs old and above to be more careful and not expose themselves unnecessarily.

3.0 MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS

3.1 Mr. Governor invited Mrs. Essien Rashidat, the Chairman of the Chairmen of Local Government and Local Council Development Areas for her contribution. She gave a word of assurance that the Chairmen in their various Local Government and Local Council Development Areas would make the publicity/awareness as a priority in their respective areas.

3.2 Mr. Governor, thereafter, invited Mr. Salisu Jimoh, Chairman Ijede LCDA for his contribution. He commended Mr. Governor's effort for the prompt action taken in order to enlighten the communities in the State. He said further that the information would get to the people at the grass root and other safety measure would be put in place to prevent spread of the virus.

3.3 Mr. Governor invited Chairman, Lagos State Community Development Advisory Council for his contribution. He assured Mr. Governor that the information would be properly disseminated to the people of the community across the 57 LG/LCDAs of the State.

The meeting commenced at 12.10 p.m. with Mr. Governor calling the meeting to order and invited HRM, Oba K.K. Agbabiaka, Osolo of Isolo to give the opening prayer.

Mr. Governor made reference to the last meeting especially the deceased Obas and called on HRM, Oba Kabiru Adewale Shotobi, Ayangburen of Ikorodu to pray for them.

Mr. Governor briefed the meeting on the Government's efforts on the COVID-19 pandemic. He said over 6000 have been infected and over 2000 have been healed. About 87 deaths, most of who were hypertensive and diabetic, have been recorded. He explained further that 15-20% of those infected have serious symptoms that need serious care and that others got

In contributing, HRM, Oba Owolabi Adeyemi Adeshina Adeniyi, Olu of Igbobi-Sabe stated that markets should be returned back to Obas, for proper management and efficiency.

HRM, Oba Mudashiru Ajibade Bakare-Agoro, Ranodu of Imota advised that there should be more stringent monitoring of the borders. This in his opinion would help in controlling the influx of people into the State, thereby reducing the spread of the corona virus pandemic. He was also of the view that it would help in striking a balance with the economy of the State.

HRM, Oba Richard Abayomi Ogunsanya, Olubeshe of Ibeshe solicited for the distribution of hand sanitizers to the citizens of the State. He went further by soliciting for enhanced security for markets, churches and mosques.

In his contribution, HRM, Oba Lateef Adams, Oba of Ikate advised that there should be massive fumigation of markets across the five (5) divisions of the State. He also stated his belief that market leaders ought to be crowned by the Obas.

All Obas reiterated the need for more massive re-orientation of the populace, to make citizens appreciate the fact that the pandemic is real, and steps should be taken to mitigate the spread of the virus.

The meeting came to a close at 1.25 pm with Mr. Governor thanking all the Obas for taking their time to connect to the meeting. He equally promised to ensure that the amended FY2020 budget shall be focused on essential expenditure, while the non-essential spends would be trimmed in the face of dwindling financial resources. Finally, Mr. Governor promised to continually strive to make life more meaningful for the entire citizens of the State.
